

Percussion Supplies for 8th Grade

Add these items to your stick bag. Don't forget your black hand towel, 2 mechanical pencils, your Basic Objectives, and your One Way Book.

Hard Rubber Mallets

E70 uses include: wood block, temple blocks, xylo., marimba (high end)

Hard Yarn Mallets



Salyers Percussion

E30 use for marimba (create a graduated set of 4 mallets using your E10 and E20 mallets)

Hard Plastic Mallets



Salyers Percussion

PCX15

(replaces DFP600 and IP906)

best for bells and crotales

Soft Timpani Mallets



Promark PST3

best for pieces requiring smooth rolls

Many 8th graders find it helpful to have a second black hand towel. Find at Target, Wal-Mart, Kohls, etc.

Avoid using Amazon (especially third-party sellers).

Your best bet is to use an online percussion retailer such as Lone Star Percussion or Steve Weiss Music.

They have the largest selection of percussion instruments, implements, and accessories.

Stores like Brook Mays, Music & Arts, and Williamsons Music 1st will be able to order most, if not all, items.

Most storefronts will *not* stock everything. **Order online and order early.** You can check other online retailers but do back-order when necessary (you'll be higher on the list when the shipment finally arrives).
